POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS AT THE TRUMAN INSTITUTE

FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021

The Institute is offering Truman Institute Post-Doctoral Fellowships (up to 2 years), the Ambassador Bill Brown Scholarship (up to 2 years), and the Maurice J. and Fay B. Karpf Peace Prize Awards (1 year) in the amount of 80,000 shekels per year for research connected to the study of peace and/or conflict resolution. Priority will be given to research in the following areas: Middle East; The Israeli-Palestinian Conflict; Jerusalem.

Only candidates who received their PhD after September 2018 may apply.

Required documents: PhD certificate (or proof that the dissertation has been submitted), CV and a list of academic publications, short description of the research to be carried out at the Institute (up to 3 pages double-spaced), and two letters of recommendation.

Successful candidates must be present at the Truman Institute at least three days per week and participate in the doctoral seminar and other activities of the Institute.
